Mr. Woodrow:

I am writing on behalf of my client, Jobiak, Inc. (“**Jobiak**”) to notify you that your unlawful use of Jobiak’s job listings (the “**Products**”) on your websites thehiringstore.com, behirednow.com and other sites you own (the “**Websites**”) infringes on Jobiak’s exclusive copyrights and trademarks. Accordingly, you are hereby directed to cease and desist all infringement and unauthorized use of the Products, including on your Websites.

All aspects of the Products are copyrighted and trademarked under United States copyright and trademark law and Jobiak is the owner of such copyright and trademark. Under United States copyright law, Jobiak’s copyrights have been in effect since the date that the Products were created.

It has come to our attention that you have been illegally posting and/or illegally using the Products on your Websites, including job descriptions, layouts, design, keyword matches (verbatim) and other data. We have copies of your Websites and offers to preserve as evidence. Your actions constitute copyright infringement in violation of the United States copyright laws. Under 17 U.S.C 504, the consequences of copyright infringement include statutory damages of between \$750 and \$30,000 per work, at the discretion of the court, and damages of up to \$150,000 per work for willful infringement. If you continue to engage in copyright infringement after receiving this letter, your actions will be evidence of “willful infringement.”

We also have strong evidence that you hacked into Jobiak’s Products (specifically, but not limited to alljobs.ai) in order to scrape all of Jobiak’s proprietary keyword data. Your actions constitute possible violations of the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act (CFAA); the Stored Communications Act (SCA); the Electronic Communications Privacy Act (ECPA); and the Defend Trade Secrets Act (DTSA). We



will not hesitate to contact authorities, including the Federal Bureau of Investigations or the US Attorney's office if these illegal activities continue.

We demand that you immediately:

- cease and desist any hacking of Jobiak's websites, data or other Products;
- cease and desist your unlawful use of the Products and remove all such Products from your Websites and any other locations where you have it;
- contact all persons and entities to whom you have directly or indirectly provided the Products and inform them that such materials were provided improperly in infringement of the rights of Jobiak;
- provide Jobiak with contact information for such all persons and entities; and
- provide Jobiak with prompt written assurance by 12:00 PM (PST) on March 25, 2022 that you have removed all of the Products from your Websites.

If you do not comply with these cease and desist demand within this time period, please be advised that Jobiak will pursue all available legal remedies, including seeking monetary damages, injunctive relief, and an order that you pay court costs and attorney's fees. In addition, Jobiak is entitled to use your failure to comply as evidence of "willful infringement" of copyright and seek monetary damages and equitable relief for your copyright infringement. In the event you fail to meet this demand, your liability and exposure under such legal action could be considerable.

Before taking these steps, however, Jobiak wishes to give you one opportunity to discontinue your illegal conduct by complying with this demand by 12:00 PM (PST) on March 25, 2022.

Dear Mr. Roy:

As noted in my March 25, 2022 communication to you, this law firm represents Aspen Technology Labs in copyright and trademark matters. We have discussed with Aspen the allegations raised in your March 23 letter, and we are writing to request that you provide us with additional detail regarding our client’s alleged wrongdoing. Your letter makes reference to purported use of “job descriptions, layouts, design, keyword matches (verbatim) and other data.” However, you have not provided any examples of this alleged copying. As I’m sure you are aware, many of the “job descriptions” that Jobiak lists come directly from the party who has posted the position, and thus would not be owned by Jobiak. And, the terms “layouts, design, keyword matches ... and other data” do not provide us with enough specificity to understand what protectable content has allegedly been taken.

Aspen takes intellectual property rights seriously, and if there is something about the way in which it is operating its site that implicates your client’s copyright, trademark, or other IP rights, it is certainly willing to consider your client’s position on that. But, at the moment, it does not have enough information to evaluate this matter. Further, to the extent that your client owns copyright registrations for any content at issue, we would appreciate your providing us with copies of those.

Lastly, your letter asserts that you have “strong evidence that [Aspen] hacked into Jobiak’s Products (specifically, but not limited to alljobs.ai) in order to scrape all of Jobiak’s proprietary



Dear Mr. Trigg,

This letter comes on behalf of our client, Jobiak, Inc. (“Jobiak” or our “Client”), in response to your letter dated March 30, 2022. In your correspondence, you request additional details regarding the infringement by your client, Aspen Technology Labs (“ATL”). We are hopeful this letter serves to guide your understanding of ATL’s wrongful actions.

More particularly, in your letter, you assert that the “job descriptions” listed by Jobiak are not owned by Jobiak. In this way, you allude to the well-established principle that facts are not copyrightable. However, our Client is not claiming copyright ownership in the *facts* but rather in original listing of available positions, which are undoubtably subject to copyright protection.

Indeed, Jobiak culls information from various sources and creates its own list of suggested jobs. Jobiak's works are therefore copyrightable. *See CDN Inc. v. Kapes*, 197 F3d 1256, 1259 (9th Cir. 1999) (citing *Feist Publications, Inc. v. Rural Tel. Serv. Co.*, 499 U.S. 340, 344, 113 L.Ed.2d 358, 111 S. Ct. 1281 (1991)).

Jobiak's layout design and search key word titles used at the end of each job description are formulated using its proprietary keyword technology. No other company uses a similar process, which is why ATL's infringement is so glaring. Moreover, in our Client's job descriptions, there are often a few irrelevant keywords which have no relation to the position listed. Notably, ATL has copied each of these dummy keywords. For example, for a "Heavy Equipment Operator" job at Amazon, our Client included search keywords like "care giver," Starbucks bartender," and "bakery wrapper," all of which appear verbatim in ATL's corresponding listing. *See EXHIBIT A*. ATL's wrongdoing is further evidenced by its alteration of its job postings/job landing pages following receipt of Jobiak's previous correspondence.

Our Client zealously protects its intellectual property and trusts that your assertion that ATL "takes intellectual property rights seriously." United States copyright laws protect original works of authorship, such as Jobiak's original job listings. Any reproduction or distribution of copyrighted material without express authorization of the copyright holder may constitute copyright infringement.
